What is Council/Senate/Students' Union (C/S/SU) Committee?

C/S/SU is a formal University committee that looks at issues of the wider student experience and reports on them to the two senior bodies of the University, Council and Senate.

C/S/SU is chaired by the Vice-Chancellor and includes a range of key senior University staff alongside some members of University Council and University Senate who have been elected specifically to sit on this committee. The aim of C/S/SU is to discuss key issues relating to the wider student experience. The Students' Union presents papers on each of its Top Ten issues for the year in addition to any significant issues that have not been discussed in another forum. The University also presents papers on student complaints, disciplinarys and appeals and sometimes papers on national activities or policy.

Role Summary

Student Reps are there to act as a voice for students, feeding into the activity that the University undertakes. They also support the Officer team in presenting their papers and to persuade and influence the University in creating positive change for students. Student Reps can also present their own papers with support from the SU.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Attend and participate at C/S/SU meetings and briefing/debriefings 4 times a year.
- Read C/S/SU Committee papers and pass on any queries or comments.
- Work with SU Officers to represent the student voice at the C/S/SU meetings.
- Interact with senior University staff on student experience issues.
- Engage with other SU process and engagement activities.

Time Commitment:

One academic year minimum. You are required to attend all briefings if you are attending the main meeting.
