1.	 Welcome and Apologies The Community Officer opened the meeting in the absence of the Chair (who arrived later in the meeting) and welcomed in the new Chair for 2024/25. Apologies were noted from: Tarini Seghal.
2.	 Community Officer Update The Community Officer (CO) provided an update on their attendance at the NUS Liberation Conference, emphasising discussions on topics such as decolonization of curriculum, support for international students, and transgender liberation. CO participated in workshops aimed at encouraging student participation in voting, including sessions specifically focused on trans liberation. Mentioned the recently released CAS report and its implications for the student community. Noted the proposal from the NUS for the formation of a liberation group for individual student membership.

3. **Group Updates**

DAG

Continuing campaigns, conducting handover for next year's committee. Issue of stage in the Edge still contested, with no new updates.

LGBT+

"Drag for Swag" event was successful; ticket sales exceeded revised expectations. Five applicants so far for the newly launched Gender Expression Fund. Weekly study mornings ongoing. Reduced bar socials, replaced with SU karaoke. Positive feedback on elections. Preparing handover for the new committee to organize an event for final year; will provide feedback to D&S members.

Race Equality

Relatively quiet; all roles except events officer filled. Handover documents need preparation but will be thorough. Chair attended the last EDIC meeting.

F&GE

Have been running a social media campaign for Women's History Month. Successful elections but a few positions open after by-election (aiming to recruit freshers). Preparing for a stall at Campus Pride.

Nightline

Progressing towards association with the National Nightline Association. Still need a secretary and treasurer but other roles filled. Two new committee members (internal and external coordinators) have previous experience, so effective work anticipated next year.
