Issue is stock levels:

- No sun hoodies in men's until Feb, only 2 colours in each gender and no overlap in terms of colour
- Lumiko T not getting any stock until NEXT winter, limited stock in any mens colour currently, but good quantities in women's blue
- Micro T none/bad stock in women's blue, good stock in mens
