Managing different abilities


- Students in your session will have different levels of knowledge, different strengths and weaknesses, and different ways they learn best
- Variety is key to making sessions accessible to everyone







Bloom's taxonomy



- Often seen as a hierarchy, explained as working up the levels.
- However, you need all levels to be able to answer questions.
- Each level is a different skill set.







Using Bloom's Taxonomy

- Bloom's taxonomy can help change the content of your session.
- In groups, imagine you're planning an essay writing session. Use the different levels to think of different activities you could run to help your group improve their essay writing skills.
- Think about time, resources, feeding back etc.







Planning an activity

- How are you arranging the group?
- How long will the activity take?
 - Feeding back to the room can take a long time if each group are participating
- Do you need any resources?
- Do you need to make breakout rooms?
