2. Do you think being a Student Trainer has helped you with your CV, your employability skills?

Yes definitely, because BBA requires you to do two placements, and they are really competitive because we all have great academic CVs, but you need a lot of extracurricular activities on top, and so when I did Student Training in my second year, I didn't have student training on my CV the first time I had my placement, so my CV was so weak, I think. And for my second placement I got Accenture. I think it was very valuable because I could actually communicate my skills, explain that I was actually delivering sessions and presentations. When you're doing consulting, at least, they ask you to present, train other people. I think Student Trainer was really helpful, working in teams because you're always co-presenting or co-delivering the session with someone else who is doing another degree and having another timetable. You have to get organised. I think there's a lot of skills to be gained from the Student Trainer programme.
