

4. What would you say your proudest moment being a Student Trainer has been, if there's one?

So I have one, which was on my final semester as a Student Trainer. We managed to organise this skills training session for refugees. They basically asked us to deliver employability skills sessions. We had 3 girls from the Student Trainer group and a translator. We had to adapt because we didn't really know what they were expecting. We picked 4 topics: Cultural Awareness, mostly related to the UK; communication skills; a CV session, related to how to write a CV, and how to do interviews and how to get a job within Bath; and time management, organising your life because most of them had families, how to apply for jobs, and some of them wanted to go to university to learn a bit of English. So it was really interesting, and in the end the charity came back to us and said 'oh it would be great if we could continue the experience'.
