RESPONDING TO STV FIRST AID INCIDENTS

INCLUDING ASTROS/TRACK/GRASS PITCHES

Contact the Shift Manager on 07980 957415, 01225 384418 or 01225 384454 giving as much detailed information about the incident as possible.



If the injury is life-threatening or serious you should not hesitate and call 999 before contacting the Shift Manager for assistance.



The Shift Manager will dispatch a first aider to the incident.



The first aider will decide on the appropriate treatment and any further action necessary.



If further medical attention is not required the first aider will give the relevant treatment, complete documentation and any remedial action.



If further medical attention is required an **ambulance (999 or 112)** will be called by the Operations Team.



Security will be informed by the Shift Manager on **ext 666** that an ambulance has been called to the University.



If available a member of the Operations Team will direct the ambulance to the casualty giving precise directions to the closest access point.



If a member of the Operations Team is not available the Shift Manager will request assistance from Security, DSDR Placement Students or DSDR staff to guide the ambulance to the casualty.





Emergency services to assess the casualty and treat accordingly.





Operations Team to complete all relevant documentation and remedial action.
