[SUMmit](#) is made up of a range of student leaders and representatives.

Who are the members of SUMmit?

- Membership of SUMmit is via two routes:
 - 20 SUMmit member roles are available for any current registered student to be elected into via online elections held at the start of each academic year,
 - A range of ex-officio roles, these are student leaders or representatives who are invited to become members of SUMmit due to the roles which they hold within The SU.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Help to shape the direction of the SU through the creation and discussion of Standpoints.
- Engage with pre-meeting discussions relating to submitted Statements of Issues.
- Attend and engage with four SUMmit meetings per year.
- Communicate with SU Officers about their updates and work relating to adopted Standpoints.
- Vote on Standpoints at meetings of SUMmit.
- Engage with your Exec/Group you are representing (for ex-officio roles) to keep them up to date with what's happening at SUMmit.
- Respond to communications relating to the operational delivery of SUMmit.
- Network and collaborate with other SUMmit members where appropriate.

Useful Previous Experience/Skills

- Enthusiasm for The SU and its activities.
- Confidence to speak in public and good verbal and written communication skills.

Key Time Commitments

- Four SUmmit meetings across the academic year (2 hours meeting, up to 1 hour dinner/networking).
- Regular email/MS Teams contact with SU staff/Officers throughout the year to facilitate the operational delivery of SUmmit.
- Requires reading of Statements of Issues and information outside of meeting times.
- One to two hours of training before starting the role (with ongoing support).
